

## 2020 NSYC Membership Cost

### A Special Note about 2020 Membership

Due to the new COVID-19 guidelines imposed by the CDC & *The Governor's Restore IL Plan*, the NSYC is not currently offering Sailing, Kayaking, or SUP classes, or any Social Events.

### NEW MEMBERSHIPS ARE BEING ACCEPTED UNDER THESE CONDITIONS

- 1) You own your own Sailboat, Kayak, SUP or Powerboat, and you transport it to the NSYC each visit for your own use, **OR**
- 2) **For experienced Sailors** you must be able to demonstrate independent skills of Swimming, Rigging, Sailing and Derigging a Sunfish sailboat without assistance prior to using NSYC sailboats.
- 3) **For experienced SUP paddlers** you must pass the SUP Swim and Skills competency assessment to qualify for NSYC SUP equipment use.
- 4) **Kayak equipment use is restricted only to renewing members** who have previously passed the Kayak Swim and Skills assessment. Please check back often as we are hopeful this restriction eases as the summer progresses.

<b>MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY</b>	<b>Cost</b>
<b>Full Membership:</b> Privileges are for all household Members including dependent children under the age of 26. Members may participate in any sailing, kayaking and SUP activities and have full use of NSYC owned recreational watercraft <b>for which they have passed our Skills, Swim and Safety competency assessment.</b>	\$310
<b>Paddle Membership:</b> Privileges are for all household Members including dependent children under the age of 26. Members may participate in paddling activities and have use of NSYC kayaks and SUPs <b>for which they have passed our Skills, Swim and Safety competency assessment.</b>	\$235
<b>Power Boat Membership:</b> For powerboat owners, all member privileges except the use of club sailboats, kayaks or SUPs.	\$165
<b>Outrigger Chicago Membership:</b> For Outrigger Chicago members, all member privileges except the use of club sailboats, kayaks or SUPs.	\$175
<b>Junior Membership:</b> for Individuals ages 13-20; Members may participate in any sailing, kayaking, SUP activities & have full use of NSYC owned watercraft <b>for which they have passed the skills, swim and safety competency assessment</b> , and in accordance with certain restrictions for minors. Junior members choose a term of membership identical to the term of all other classes of membership (Jan 1 to Dec 31) or, an academic year term from August 1 to July 31.	\$115
<b>Reciprocal Member:</b> Must be a member of another yacht club with paid dues greater than or equal to that of NSYC. List Home Club name (Dues for the home club plus dues for NSYC must equal a minimum of \$310 or the differential is to be added to NSYC dues).	\$140 +

<b>Learn To Sail – Adult Sailing Lessons:</b>	N/A

Meets for 10 weekly sessions; August to October. Participants must be either a child of a current Full Member, or a Junior Member of the NSYC.	\$75

## A Summary Parking Guide for the Park Ave Boating Facility (PABF)

Parking at the PABF is independently managed by the Park District of Highland Park (PDHP) and the parking rules are strictly enforced by the Highland Park Police Department (HPPD). A PABF Parking Sticker Decal and the Master Lock® Vault Enterprise App (Bluetooth enabled) will be required to access or park at this location. Violations are subject to a costly parking ticket. **Please visit the PDHP's website for a detailed schedule of PDHP Parking Rules at: <https://www.pdhp.org/beaches/parking-2/>**

**How to Purchase a PABF Decal:** Park Ave Beach Parking Decals are available for purchase beginning June 10<sup>th</sup> only at the Recreation Center of Highland Park, 1207 Park Ave West, Highland Park.

Rec Center Hours are M -Th 6am-6pm, Fri/Sat/Sun 6am-2pm.

**Paid NSYC membership will be verified by the PDHP** before a NSYC PABF Parking Decal (discounted for non-residents) will be issued and verification may take up to 7 days from the date you join.

**Boat owners who pay the PDHP for seasonal boat storage at Park Ave Beach** will receive one seasonal PABF Parking Sticker as part of their annual boat owner's storage fee and will not need to purchase Parking separately. <https://www.pdhp.org/boating/launching-storage-information/>

PABF Parking Stickers are not transferrable and must be displayed on the vehicle's front windshield, passenger side.
