2021 New Memberships Are Being Accepted Under the Following Conditions:

You own your own Sailboat, Kayak, Stand Up Paddleboard (SUP), or Powerboat and you transport it to the NSYC each visit for your own use, **OR**

»**Experienced Sailors** must be able to demonstrate independent skills of Swimming, Rigging, Sailing and De-rigging a Sailboat (Sunfish, Barnett, 420, Buccaneer, or HobieCat16) without assistance, prior to using NSYC sailboats.

»**SUP paddlers** must pass a Swim and Skills competency assessment to qualify for NSYC SUP equipment use.

»**Kayakers: equipment use** is restricted to renewing members who have previously passed Swim and Kayak Skills assessment.

Minor children of members (under 18) must be accompanied at the NSYC, and on the water, by an adult member at all times.

Additionally, ALL members agree to follow the NSYC COVID-19 Published Guidelines and the NSYC Handbook for Safety and Equipment Use Rules, available at www.NorthShoreYachtClub.com.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY	Cost
Full Membership: Privileges are for all household Members including dependent children under the age of 26. Members may participate in any sailing, kayaking and SUP activities and have full use of NSYC owned recreational watercraft for which they have passed our Skills, Swim and Safety competency assessment .	\$310
Paddle Membership: Privileges are for all household Members including dependent children under the age of 26. Members may participate in paddling activities and have use of NSYC kayaks and SUPs for which they have passed our Skills, Swim and Safety competency assessment .	\$235
Power Boat Membership: For powerboat owners, all member privileges except the use of club sailboats, kayaks or SUPs.	\$165
Junior Membership: for Individuals ages 13-20; Members may participate in any sailing, kayaking, SUP activities & have full use of NSYC owned watercraft for which they have passed the skills, swim and safety competency assessment , and in accordance with certain restrictions for minors. Junior members choose a term of membership identical to the term of all other classes of membership (Jan 1 to Dec 31) or, an academic year term from August 1 to July 31.	\$115
Outrigger Chicago Membership: For Outrigger Chicago members, all member privileges except the use of club sailboats, kayaks or SUPs.	\$175
Reciprocal Member: Must be a member of another yacht club with paid dues greater than or equal to that of NSYC. List Home Club name (Dues for the home club plus dues for NSYC must equal a minimum of \$310 or the differential is to be added to NSYC dues).	\$140 +
ADDITIONAL SERVICES	
Adult Sailing Lessons: <u>Vaccinations of Instructors/students may be required.</u> Choose from one of two sessions offered on Saturday or Sunday morning for a total of 7 classes. Classes are led by U.S. Sailing-certified leaders as well as experienced NSYC volunteers. All sailing equipment is provided, except for personal water gear and U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets.
